

PROM IDOL SHOW GUIDELINES

Parent Permission is REQUIRED for each participant under the age of 18 years old.

Act/s MUST consist of currently-enrolled students.

- 1.) Parents are responsible for transportation for their children to and from auditions, the dress rehearsal, and talent show.
- 2.) The Talent Show Committee retains final approval of all acts.
- 3.) **NO** profanity or vulgar lyrics will be permitted in any performance. This is a family friendly competition!!!
- 4.) Acts will be allotted no more than **FIVE (5) MINUTES** to perform.
Acts will be **DISQUALIFIED** if time is exceeded.
- 5.) Participants may only perform in **ONE** act. Any participant who performs in more than one will disqualify **BOTH** acts.
- 6.) Small groups of students may perform together, but please remember the show will be on a stage so space will be limited.
- 7.) Keep attire at a respectable and tasteful level. **NO** alcohol, tobacco, or drug advertisements are to be shown on any clothing. Photos of your costume/s must be submitted electronically by no later than Dec 31, 2018, for approval. All attire is subject to Show Management approval.
- 8.) Pyrotechnics, open flames or any other dangerous or hazardous additions to the performance will **NOT** be permitted. Acts requiring more than **12 FEET** of ceiling height will not be permitted. performances are subject to Show Management approval.
- 9.) You will need to electronically submit a copy of your music for approval upon the completion of your application. If your music is not submitted along with your application the application will **NOT** be accepted. Your music should be clearly labeled with your name and the title of your music selection.
- 10.) A Sound Technician and microphone(s) will be provided. We will need to be notified in advance if you require more than two microphones. If you choose to use your own microphone it must be wired and **NOT** wireless.
- 11.) **EVERY** participant **must** attend the information session pertaining to Prom Idol.
- 12.) **NO** changes to your music selection will be accepted after December 31st, 2018.
- 13.) Prom Idol, Once Upon a Prom are not responsible for theft/damage or injury of any kind, to persons or instruments, props, clothing, equipment, etc., during, before or after the performance.
- 14.) Prom Idol holds the right to use contestant's name, photo/and or video for any further publicity purposes.
- 15.) Organizers reserve the right of final decision on any matters pertaining to Prom Idol not covered by the rules.

The decisions made by the Judges and/or Show Management, in setting rules and evaluating a performance are considered final and are not subject to complaint or alteration.

Eligibility:

- ❖ The competition is open to all currently enrolled students from Elementary to University level.
- ❖ Talents may include (but not limited to) singing, dancing, instrumental, magic, comedy, NO LIP-SYNCHING ACTS.
- ❖ Everyone must return a completed and signed Prom Idol Participation Form.
- ❖ Students who are part of a group act should submit their Participation Forms together.
- ❖ Recommended length of act is 3 minutes to a maximum of approximately 5 minutes.
- ❖ Maximum number of participants in an act is 8.
- ❖ Costumes must be appropriate for all age groups.
- ❖ Absolutely NO profanity of insensitive subject matter will be permitted in your performance or music.
- ❖ Acts are responsible for their own props and costumes.
- ❖ All performances will be screened for appropriateness by Show Management.
- ❖ If your act includes accompanying music, the music must be provided to Show Coordinators at time of auditions. It must be labeled with your name and the name of the song.
- ❖ Acts with any member under the age of 18 must have a consent form signed by their parents. If there is no consent form then you will NOT be allowed to participate.

Talent Competition Rules and Regulations

1. Acts requiring more than **12 FEET** of ceiling height will not be allowed.
2. Acts will be allotted no more than **FIVE (5) MINUTES** to perform. Acts will be **PENALIZED** if time is exceeded.
3. Participants may only perform **ONE** time during the show. Any participant who participates in more than one performance will disqualify **BOTH** acts.
4. **NO** profanity or vulgar lyrics in any vocal performance or dance music. This is a family show!!!
5. Keep attire at a respectable and tasteful level.
NO alcohol, tobacco, or drug advertisements are to be shown on any clothing.
6. **NO** pyrotechnics, open flames or any other dangerous additions.
7. Sound Technician and microphone(s) will be provided. **YOU** must provide your own CD music, taped music, instruments, props, keyboard, etc., if needed.

NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE TO THESE RULES!!!
